GAME DAY STUDENT-ATHLETE CONTRACT

Participation in athletics is a privilege, not a right. The athlete must earn this privilege through dedication, desire, and discipline. Without the pursuit of those, the athlete can in no way do justice to themselves or the school. The athlete must discipline himself or herself to be a good citizen and student in order to achieve athletic excellence. The Administration, Faculty and Coaching staff at De Anza High School believes that the tradition of winning is established and maintained upon these principles. In order for these goals to be achieved, the following contract must be understood and agreed to between the school, the Student-Athlete, and parents.

The Administration at De Anza High School reserves the right to prohibit the Student-Athlete listed below from participating in athletic contests if found in violation of the following policies on the day of the contest.

PARTICIPATION ON GAME DAY WILL BE REVOKED IF THE STUDENT-ATHLETE:

1. Does not attend 5 out of 6 classes of their daily class schedule. Exceptions can be made (for 1 class only) for doctor appointments, funerals, medical emergencies, with proper documentation. Leaving class early for a contest does not affect the Student-Athlete.
2. Does not sign this contract within 1 week of receipt with signature of parent/guardian.
3. Receives a referral.
4. Is cutting class or off-campus.
5. Is found in possession or use of illegal substances. (Tobacco, alcohol, or drugs)
6. Is involved in a fight.
7. Is in possession of a weapon.
8. Is suspected of gambling.
9. Does not dress properly for P.E. class or is a disruption in the locker room.
10. Is reported by any faculty member for inappropriate, disruptive, or rude behavior.
11. Displays any behavior unbecoming a Student-Athlete at De Anza High School.
12. If any unacceptable behavior occurs on game day but is not brought to the attention of the Administration, Athletic Director, or Coaching Staff on the day of the contest, the student-athlete will not participate in the following game/match.
